The University is looking for meritorious, energetic and dedicated persons to be appointed in some temporary posts of teachers (to teach at PG level and conduct research projects) Applications with all relevant testimonials from such intending candidates having UGC norms are invited so as to reach the undersigned on or before **5th June, 2015**.

Posts of Teacher:

- (A) **Professor/Associate Professor** (pay as per UGC Scale): one each in (i) Sankaradeva Studies, (ii) Assamese, (iii) Education, (iv) Sociology, (v) Juridical Studies, (vi) Social Works and (vii) Performing Arts;
- (B) **Assistant Professor** (pay: UGC/Basic + AGP of UGC Scale): two each in (i) Assamese, (ii) Education, (iii) Sociology (iv) Juridical Studies (V)Social Works (vi) Performing Arts (Music and Dance) (vii) Sankaradeva Studies and (viii) Yoga Science

DETAILED INFORMATION

The prescribed application forms shall be issued from **20th May, 2015**, which can be obtained from the office of **the Registrar, Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya, Kalongpar, Nagaon** on payment of **Rs 1,000/-** (Rupees One Thousand only), the receipt of which must be enclosed with the filled in application form. The application form may be downloaded from the University's website www.mssv.co.in The application must accompany a **Demand Draft of Rs**

1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) in favour of the “**Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya,**” payable at **State Bank of India, Nagaon Main Branch** as application fee.

No application shall be received after the last date.

Only short listed candidates shall be called for interview. Canvassing directly or indirectly shall disqualify a candidate.

I. Eligibility to apply for the posts:

1. The Applicant must be a citizen of India.
2. He/she must be medically fit both in mind and in body-a certificate duly signed by the District Medical Officer, Nagaon District or any competent Registered Medical Officer, approved by the Vice-Chancellor, shall have to be produced by any person who would be appointed as a Teacher, before/she is allowed to join.
3. A certificate about good character from the Head of the Institution last attended or served shall accompany an application for any post of Teacher.
4. The candidate must possess the minimum qualifications for the post.
5. Upper age limit of the candidates, if otherwise not mentioned, shall be as per the Govt. of Assam rules / norms.

II. General Qualification, Experience and Requirements:

1. Assistant Professor: Minimum qualification and experience:

- (i) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or Ph.D. Degree (under the New Regulations)

2. Associate Professor: Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- (i) Good academic record with a Ph. D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- (ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- (iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/College excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research papers in the subject concerned.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) A minimum API score of 300 points as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) as per the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC's revised Regulation of minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers.

3. Professor: Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- (a)
 - (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
 - (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
 - (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
 - (iv) A minimum API score of 400 points as stipulated in the Academic

Performance Indicator (API) as per the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC's revised Regulation of minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers.

OR

- (b) An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.
- (c) **Upper Age Limit:** A person **upto the age of 63 years** with the above qualifications may apply for the posts of Professor.

(III) Desirable qualification:

For the posts in Sankaradeva Studies/Performing Arts competence in the relevant area concerned are desirable.

(IV) Conditions to be fulfilled after appointment:

1. A person appointed to the post of a Teacher shall join **within one month from the date of issue of appointment order**, failing which the appointment order is liable to be cancelled. Provided that in exceptional circumstances, the Vice-Chancellor may extend this period.
2. Before a person appointed to the post of a Teacher joins in his/her post, he/she shall execute an agreement with the university that he/she shall strictly abide by the provisions of the Act, Statutes and Ordinances of the University. A Teacher shall also undertake in the agreement to submit to the Vice-Chancellor a self-appraisal report of his/her performance annually.
3. The person, after joining the post of Teacher, will be subjected to the provisions of the MSSV Teachers' Service Conditions Ordinance.


